



For the first time in our history, I am pleased to announce the Midlothian Fire Department has achieved a Class 3 ISO rating. I want to thank all our fire department personnel, and village staff who worked cohesively to make this happen. This achievement speaks to the dedication and commitment that the Village of Midlothian has for the improvement of our emergency services in the community.

The Insurance Services Office (ISO) evaluates communities and their fire departments throughout the country. Each community is given a Public Protection Classification from 1 to 10, with 1 being the highest rating. ISO class communities may enjoy lower insurance premiums. Approximately 3663 fire departments, less than 5% of more than 72,160 departments in the United States, are ISO Class 3.

We have a great fire department and we're proud to announce this most recent achievement to our Village, residents and business community. This is yet another reason to choose Midlothian as a great place to live, work, raise a family, and do business."
