## ORDINANCE #2180

### AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LEVYING AND ASSESSMENT OF TAXES FOR FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 2025, AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2026

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE  
VILLAGE OF MIDLOTHIAN, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

**SECTION 1:** That heretofore an Ordinance styled "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING AN APPROPRIATION FOR CORPORATE PURPOSES BY THE VILLAGE OF MIDLOTHIAN, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 2025 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2026 was duly passed and approved on April 23, 2025, and was duly published according to law, there having been appropriated for the municipal fiscal year beginning May 1, 2025 and ending April 30, 2026, the sum of **\$42,859,471** for the corporate objects and purposes as set forth in Section 3 hereby under the heading "APPROPRIATION".

**SECTION 2:** Said President and Board of Trustees, in accordance with the statute in such case made and provided, having duly ascertained and hereby fix and determine the total amount of the appropriations for all corporate purposes legally made and to be collected from the tax levy for the current fiscal year to be the sum of **\$8,867,667**.

**SECTION 3:** That the sums or amounts appropriated to be collected from the tax levy for the current fiscal year and used for each purpose respectively, as summarized and itemized below, are ascertained as follows under the heading "TO BE RAISED BY TAX LEVY".

**SECTION 4:** That all the unexpended balance of any item or items of a general Appropriation made in this Ordinance be expended in making up any deficiency in any item or items in the same general purpose or in like Appropriation made by this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by Law.

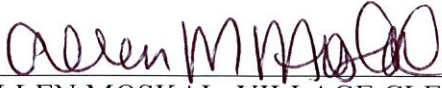
